

# Sowing and Reaping

**Text: Galatians 6:7-9** Dual themes: Sowing and Reaping / Life and Death

As we seek to exercise our faith, we are constantly faced with *choices* that we must make in regard to how much we will actually allow our actions to follow our words.

**I. The nature of the seed determines the nature of the harvest (vv.7-8).**

A. Good seed needs good ground.

B. The act of sowing is the act of obedience.

*(We can plant our seed or we can eat it. It is our choice.)*

**II. God's laws determine the harvest we receive (vv.7-8).**

A. God is sovereign. He will not be mocked.

B. Spiritual laws are principles set by God and work as God has ordained.

**III. Our faith, put into action according to God's Word, determine our harvest (vv.8-9).**

A. We must maintain our faith in God's benevolent character.

B. Opportunities to exercise our faith must be seized.

At times "talking faith" is much different than "walking out our faith." Nevertheless, when we make our *choices* according to God's Word, and stand with Him, we will not be disappointed in the results.
