Text: Matthew 2:13-23

For thousands of years following the exodus of the Israelites from Egypt, Jesus, the Son of God, was also “called out” of Egypt for you and me.

I. Egypt Has Always Been A Place of Bondage and Death.

- a. Egypt is a “type” of the world under the curse of sin.
- b. The Son of God came into the world, but could not be overcome by it. (Jn.1:1-5)

II. The Father Delivered His Son Out of Egypt.

- a. The Son of God passed through “Egypt”/the world victoriously. (Phil 2 & Hebrews 4:15)
- b. His obedience delivered us from our disobedience and from “Egypt.” (Hebrews 10; Romans 8:32)

III. Jesus Has Come to Lead Us Out of Egypt

- a. As Messiah, He is the leader of God’s people (Acts 3:18-23 & Acts 26:19-23).
- b. As Savior, He is the deliverer of God’s people (Romans 1:16)
- c. As King, He rules without bondage and oppression (1 Timothy 6:11-16).

Everything about the life and ministry of Jesus Christ was about deliverance for those who will call upon His name. He came into this world to be with us so that we could leave this world and be with Him.
